March 2009 Booster Minutes (3-10-09)

The next Booster Club meeting is April 21, 6:30 PM at WolfPack Theater.

- Meeting called to order at 6:40PM
- Staff and officer introduction due to large number of first time attendees
- Ms P. states that Kristy Mapes will have to take over the choreography of the Wiz. Student that was handling it had too many commitments and was unable to complete the task.
- Ms P. states that a large number of sewers will be needed as there will be about 100 costumes.
- Builders for the set will be needed as well. Tentative dates for set build and sewing are April 18 and April 25th.
- VIP seats will be available, 9 per show, for \$25.
- Attendee asked about filming of The Wiz for distribution to parents and Ms P. stated emphatically that due to recent lawsuits brought against local theater for copyright infringement.
- Mike Walters – Chairperson took over and stated that tickets are available on booster club website, mlktheaterboosters.org via Seat Yourself.
- Mr. Schauer volunteered to help with a seating map of the auditorium. For posting on Seat Yourself for ticket purchases.
- Discussion was brought up about general seating, reserved seating and VIP seating and whether or not the entire theatre should be up for general seating or if we should explore having some reserved seating. Schauer and Walters will investigate and discuss further.
- Meeting shifted focus to discussion of Casino night on March 28th and whether or not it will go forward.
- Tickets \$25 per person and not enough tickets have been sold to hold the event.
- Donations are also needed. So far only Mike Walters, Carolyn Tomas and Mary Beth Miller have provided donations. Lenny Pipitone also got \$200 worth of oil changes from Riverside Car Clinic.
- Boosters need students to sell tickets.
- Motion was made to offer the student that sold the most tickets a \$50 visa card. Minimum of 10 tickets need to be sold for a student to be eligible.
- Advertising is on booster web page and through Zevents via Press Enterprise online. Calientes is also advertising.
- Final committee meeting to be at Calientes on the 17th to determine if enough tickets have been sold in order to move forward.
- Concession stand signups for The Wiz were started by Dale Price.
- Determined that the next meeting will be April 14th. (Since changed to the 21st due to scheduling conflicts).
