WPPBC Meeting Minutes - October 2009

- Meeting called to order at 6:33PM
- Welcome to all for a new year. 31 members in attendance
- Mike Walters/Chairperson made introductions of himself and Bianca Hamblin as returning treasurer. MaryBeth Miller, last year's Vice Chair, is no longer involved and has resigned. This leaves open the Vice Chair and Secretary positions.
- Ms. P. discussed the fall play, *How To Succeed In Business Without Really Trying*. Play to be held November 5th – 7th and 12th, 13th and 15th. All performances 7PM except for 15th a 1PM matinee.
- Ticket prices again \$10 and VIP if sold will be \$25.
 - Set build dates are October 17-Firm and October 31-if needed.
 - Members who can sew will be needed.
 - Painting and basic building will be needed as well.
 - Need: men's and women's suits, 3 ceramic toilets for scene in play, men's leather lace up shoes, banks of lockers for actors to lock up valuables during plays and practices, 7 faucet sets that need to match, women may need to buy their character's shoes, 8 old typewriters, 1960s bar, Tea cart, Old briefcases, 60s era hats.
- Ms. P will write out a How To Succeed rehearsal schedule and send home with Actors
- Fees cannot be charged any longer according to RUSD so Boosters will be more important than ever. This means that Ms. P. may not be able to do certain things this year such as Fullerton festival etc due to transportation costs etc.
- Absolutely NO videotaping of play performances again this year. (Lawsuit potential is very real)
- Boosters received official 501c3 status in August of this year
- Fundraising ideas needed: parents donate baked goods for concessions, yard sale, advertising from businesses in programs & posters, recycling, 50/50 raffles at intermissions, theme based baskets to raffle, Chili's, Ralphs script program.
- Program printing this year has to change due to cost of color ink and paper. Request made to see if anyone knows a local printer that would be able to give the school a deal.
- Member Beth Martin will look in to the RUSD print shop and get some prices for program printing.
- Ms. P. asked if anyone knew a contractor that could possibly put in a bid or help with a bid for making a useable platform above the control room. One parent stepped forward and will get back with Ms. P.
- Chili's restaurant was mentioned as possible for donation on play night-give a portion of receipts for a particular event, should also check with CoCos, Smokey Canyon BBQ and Baskin Robbins.

- Tickets available through Seat Yourself on the theater booster website.
- VIP ticket committee needed. Parent member Jane Reynolds volunteered to head the committee and organize this for How To Succeed.
- Press releases are needed. Tech student Kyle Anderson volunteered to help with this as he knows someone who does press releases.
- Next meeting set for October 8th.
